Canada's Information Commissioners call on their respective governments to create a legislated duty requiring public entities to document matters related to their deliberations, actions and decisions.

WHITEHORSE – Yukon's Information and Privacy Commissioner refers to a resource that summarizes the lack of a legislated duty to document, and the resulting effect that continues to produce an accountability gap in access to information and records management legislation; the duty to document should focus on the creation and retention of the right records, and creation of documents depending on the business needs of public agencies and community expectations.
